VOTING BY MAIL IN TEXAS

The first step is to fill out an Application for Ballot by Mail (ABBM). You can find and print the application at VoteTexas.gov or request one from your county's election office.

On your ABBM and mail ballot carrier envelope, you must provide either:

1. Your Texas Driver License, Personal ID, or Election Identification Certificate number; OR
2. The last 4 digits of your Social Security Number.

You are welcome to provide both numbers. If you have not been issued one of these numbers, you must indicate that by checking the appropriate box on the ABBM or carrier envelope.

† The Texas Election ID Certificate is a free photo ID issued by DPS for voting purposes. The number on this ID is NOT your Voter Unique Identifier (VUID) on the voter registration card you receive in the mail. Your VUID is NOT required information on either your ABBM or mail ballot carrier envelope.
